Terms and Conditions of use.

1. Garden season tickets can be used to gain access to the gardens on any standard open day during the 2020 season (12th April – 30th September).
House & Garden: Sundays and bank holiday Mondays from April 12th until August 31st, also every Wednesday in September.
Garden Only Open Days: Monday to Thursday from May 11th until September 3rd.
2. A Garden Season Pass offers repeated access to the Garden on public open days only and is not valid for special events.
3. For each visit a valid Photo ID must be presented along with a Garden Season Pass card at the admissions point.
4. Up to three accompanying children (aged 0-16yrs) receive free admission with each Garden Season Pass holder.
5. Concession pass is applicable to visitors aged 60+ years.
6. Deene Park reserves the right to close the House, Park and Gardens without prior notice.
7. Any visitor forgetting to bring their pass will be required to pay for admission. No refunds will be issued for duplicate tickets.
8. Lost passes will need to be replaced and will incur a £3 administration fee.
9. Garden season passes cannot be used in conjunction with any other offer or membership, e.g. Gardeners World, CPRE, Historic Houses, RHS.
10. Disabled carers are admitted to Deene Park free of charge when they are accompanying a disabled visitor who has purchased a Garden Season Pass. If the carer wishes to visit the grounds without the disabled visitor, they will be required to purchase an admission ticket.
11. Admission into the House is not included with a Garden Season Pass. House admission will only be granted to visitors who have upgraded to a full House ticket on the day of visiting.
12. Garden season passes are non-refundable and non-transferrable and any pass being used fraudulently will be withdrawn.
13. Dogs are not permitted in the Garden but visitors may bring them into the parkland. Only assistance dogs are permitted past our admissions point and into the Garden.
